**Note:**

1. On 17th November 2009, 47160 passengers have been screened at 22 Airports with 83 counters manned by 225 doctors and 172 paramedics. Total passengers screened till date is 8736611.
2. Till date, samples from 80839 persons have been tested for Influenza A H1N1 in Government Laboratories and a few private Laboratories across the country and 15926 (19.7%) of them have been found positive.
3. Of the 200 cases reported during the day all are indigenous cases.
4. Confirmation by the Health departments of States of Rajasthan (Two deaths) and Orissa (One death) have been received and are reflected in the cumulative total.
