**Note:**

1. On 25<sup>th</sup> November 2009, 56481 passengers have been screened at 22 Airports with 83 counters manned by 225 doctors and 172 paramedics. Total passengers screened till date is 9185581.
2. Till date, samples from 85302 persons have been tested for Influenza A H1N1 in Government Laboratories and a few private Laboratories across the country and 17486 (20.4%) of them have been found positive.
3. All of the 260 cases reported during the day are indigenous cases.
4. One death from Punjab has been reported during the day.
5. \*Laboratory confirmation of 30 old cases( Haryana-14, Chandigarh-12 & Punjab-4) has been received and is reflected in the cumulative total.
