**Note:**

1. On 28th October 2009, 41953 passengers have been screened at 22 Airports with 83 counters manned by 225 doctors and 172 paramedics. Total passengers screened till date is 7799017.
2. Till date, samples from 72483 persons have been tested for Influenza A H1N1 in Government Laboratories and a few private Laboratories across the country and 13722 (18.9%) of them have been found positive.
3. Of the 75 cases reported during the day, five cases have foreign travel history and rest are indigenous.
4. One death (Maharashtra) was reported during the day.
5. Laboratory confirmation of five deaths from Karnataka has been received which are now reflected in the cumulative total.
6. Government of Andaman & Nicobar has reported 14 positive cases which occurred between 1st September 2009 to 16<sup>th</sup> October 2009, and now has been reflected in the cumulative total.
